COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

The trainings offered by for the School for Leadership and Educational Development can be categorized into several key areas, each addressing different aspects of professional and personal development. Here are the categories and their corresponding courses:

LEADER DEVELOPMENT TRAININGS

Empowering Others to Lead (1 CEU):

This training will equip participants to identify, develop, and inspire new leadership potential within ministry or workplace. The strategies learned will help empower emerging leaders to successfully guide others with skill, purpose, and passion.

Building Trust: Six Principles for Stronger Relationships (1 CEU):

Participants will explore the causes of difficult behaviors, develop strategies to stay calm under pressure, and apply communication techniques that foster mutual respect. Building trust in relationships—whether personal or professional—requires consistency, integrity, and genuine care. This training equips leaders to strengthen relationships, enhance team cohesion, and create a culture of understanding and collaboration.

Leading Crucial Conversations (1 CEU):

This training course provides guidance and skills for how to engage in sensitive conversations that may challenge others' opinions and demand accountability while maintaining a safe space for sharing. Participants will learn how to address opposing opinions and manage strong emotions when stakes are high.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAININGS

Activating Spiritual Gifts (1 CEU):

Discover the beauty and purpose of spiritual gifts in this inspiring and in-depth experience. Participants will explore the connection between their gifts and unique calling, gaining a deeper understanding of how to activate and apply these gifts to glorify God and serve others. Participants will complete a spiritual gifts assessment to help uncover their spiritual blueprint.

Combating Burnout: Managing A Work-Life Balance (1 CEU):

Burnout is a common issue in today's fast-paced work environments, affecting individuals across various industries.

This thought-provoking training helps combat burnout and promote a healthy work-life balance. Participants will explore the components of burnout, discover practical steps to alleviate stress, and regain control of their lives.

Navigating the Clock for Success (1 CEU):

In this fast-paced world, people must manage time in a way that allows them to thrive beyond survival mode. This time management workshop examines unique perceptions of time and priorities, helps recognize personal time management deterrents, and gives strategies and tools to establish an effective life rhythm.

TEAM DEVELOPMENT TRAININGS

Discovering and Navigating Your TruNorth Communication Style (1 CEU):

This training teaches participants more contemporary communication skills through the TruNorth model. Explore the four communication Navigators to discover your unique characteristics and learn how they influence your approach in responding to others. By identifying your personal style and appreciating others' styles, you will gain the competence and confidence to engage others with greater clarity, empathy, and impact.

Managing Relationships and Conflict (1CEU):

Difficult people can be found in every workplace, ministry, or community, and managing these relationships requires patience, understanding, and effective strategies. This course equips participants with practical tools to manage challenging interactions with confidence and grace. Participants will learn relationship-building strategies to help teams solve interpersonal conflicts, apply emotional intelligence, and communicate in ways that foster forgiveness and cohesion.

Motivation, Morale & Engagement for Teams (1 CEU):

In this highly interactive group training, participants will explore skills, insights and strategies to maximize impact for the kingdom God. Emphasis on shaping a motivational workplace helps increase engagement, productivity and morale. This training provides tools and insights to establish a culture of high work-place performance, connectedness and creativity.

COACHING SKILLS

The IDEA Coaching Pathway (2 CEUs):

Step away from the noise and engage in a journey of listening to God's voice. Our coaching Skills Training, utilizing the powerful IDEA Coaching pathway, provides a unique platform for spiritual, emotional, and holistic growth. By mastering four core skills, participants gain the ability to facilitate effective coaching conversations that lead to profound change and transformation.

DISCIPLESHIP DEVELOPMENT - COME TO THE TABLE (CTTT)

Developing Christian Disciples - Part 1 (2 CEUs):

Developing Christian Disciples is a biblical group study designed to help individuals recognize that to be a strong Christian leader, one must first start with being a strong disciple of Jesus. Through a transformative journey of discovery and growth, participants will gain a deep understanding of what it means to be a true disciple of Jesus and learn how to apply these principles to their daily lives.

Walking As A Leader - Part 2 (2 CEUs):

Walking as a Leader is an impactful study that empowers participants to make a deeper connection between their identity as a disciple of Jesus and their role as a leader in their organization or ministry.

Living Out God's Plan - Part 3 (2 CEUs):

Living Out God's Plan is an inspirational study designed for discipled leaders to live out God's plan for their lives and teams. Participants will explore the many dimensions of Christian leadership, from discernment and prayer to service and community, through interactive activities.

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP AND FORMATION

Focus Living - Purpose, Vision, and Values (2 CEUs):

Focus Living is a foundational training process in our comprehensive leadership development series, emphasizing purpose, vision, and core values. This immersive and experiential process helps Christ-followers clarify their life direction and personal calling, enabling them to become influential leaders in all areas of life.

Apex - Becoming a Purpose-Driven Leader (2 CEUs):

Apex is a forward-looking training that empowers Christian leaders to gain clarity on their primary role and unique contribution to God's Kingdom. Participants explore their gifts, talents, and strengths through immersive activities, cultivating a deeper understanding of their motivations and goals. They acquire practical tools to build an authentic relationship with God and discover a purpose grounded in faith. Through discernment and self-discovery, participants align their talents, skills, and values with their life's purpose.

Resonance - Creating a Lasting Legacy (2 CEUs):

Resonance is an empowering training that helps Christian leaders identify their authentic influence and create a meaningful legacy. Through immersive activities, participants explore leadership dimensions and acquire practical tools for building a strong, influential legacy aligned with their unique contributions and values. They understand their motivations deeply and how to align talents, skills, and values with their life's purpose.

ACADEMY FOR MISSION PREPAREDNESS (AMP)

Know God - Know Self - Know the Mission

The Academy for Mission Preparedness (AMP) is a resource tool designed for mission- and ministry-minded individuals seeking to further develop their gifts and skills. The overall goal is to provide a clear, accessible pathway for participants to deepen their impact for God in today's world. All courses are self-paced and offered online.




